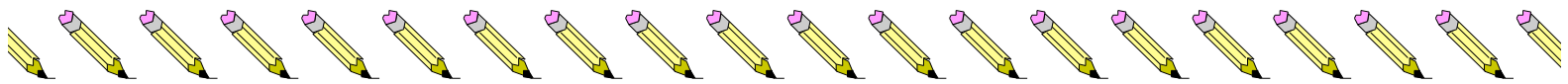

The programs are designed to meet the learning challenges of our students who may have difficulty with reading, written language, math, and may be easily distracted or have difficulty following directions. Multiple opportunities will be provided for students to practice expressing themselves particularly in social situations.
